BNP Paribas is taking three series of actions on its operational Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions: the reduction of energy consumption linked to its own operation, the use of low-carbon electricity (77% in 2021) and offsetting residual emissions.

In 2021, the Group offset 213,911 teqCO $_2$ . This compensation was made for the benefit of 4 projects:

- the preservation and restoration of 200,000 hectares of forest in Kenya with the NGO Wild Life Works;
- the construction of 13,000 gas bio-composters in India with the GoodPlanet Foundation, thus avoiding CO<sub>2</sub> emissions and preserving forests;
- the implementation of improved cooking stones and drinkable water systems to combat child undernutrition in Peru with the local NGO ITYF;
- the conservation of tropical peat bogs covering more than 150,000 hectares of swamp forest located in Indonesia with the NGO Permian Global.
