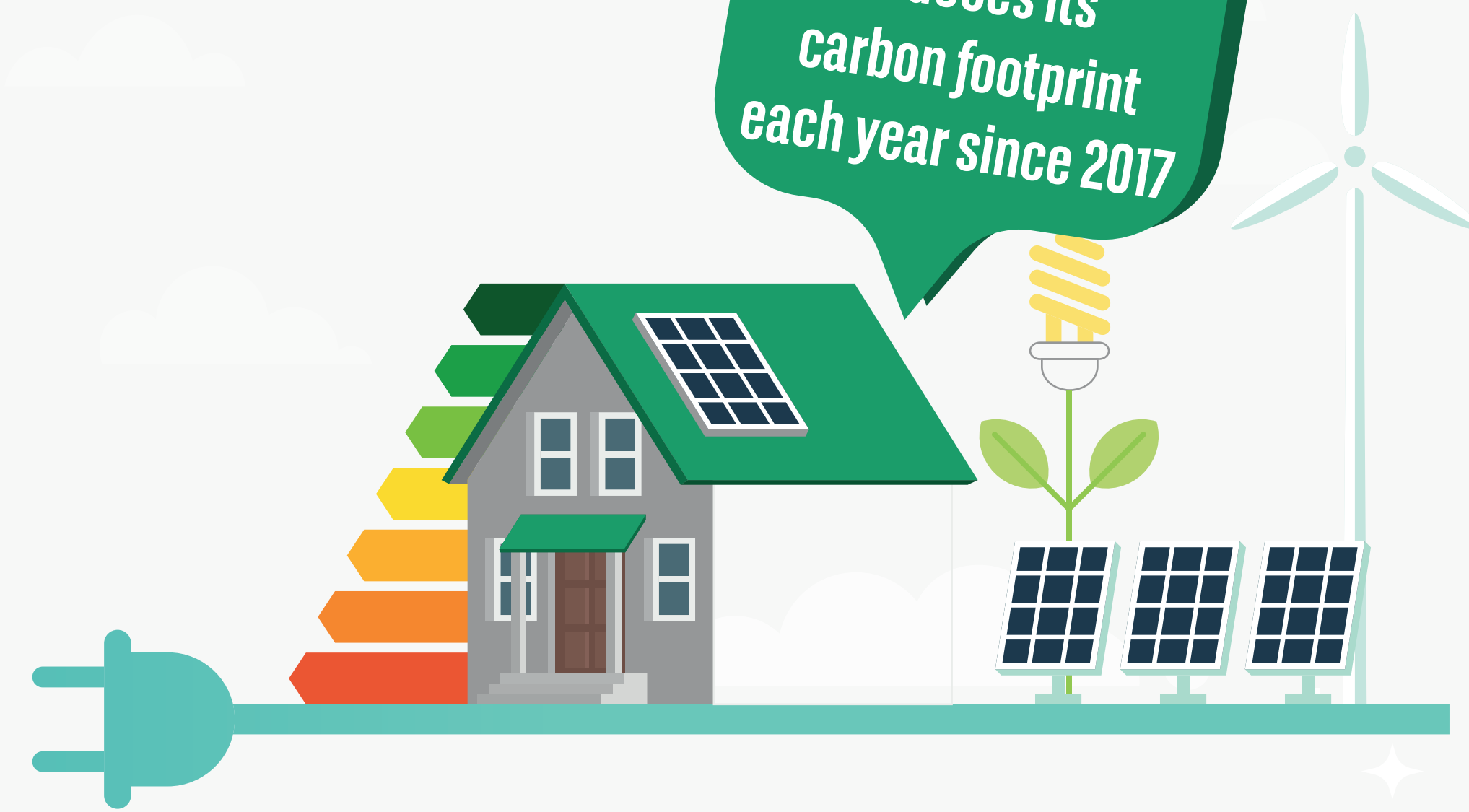


2021: THE ENVIRONMENTAL DIRECT IMPACTS

BNP Paribas is taking three series of actions on its operational Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions: the reduction of energy consumption linked to its own operation, the use of low-carbon electricity (77% in 2021) and offsetting residual emissions.

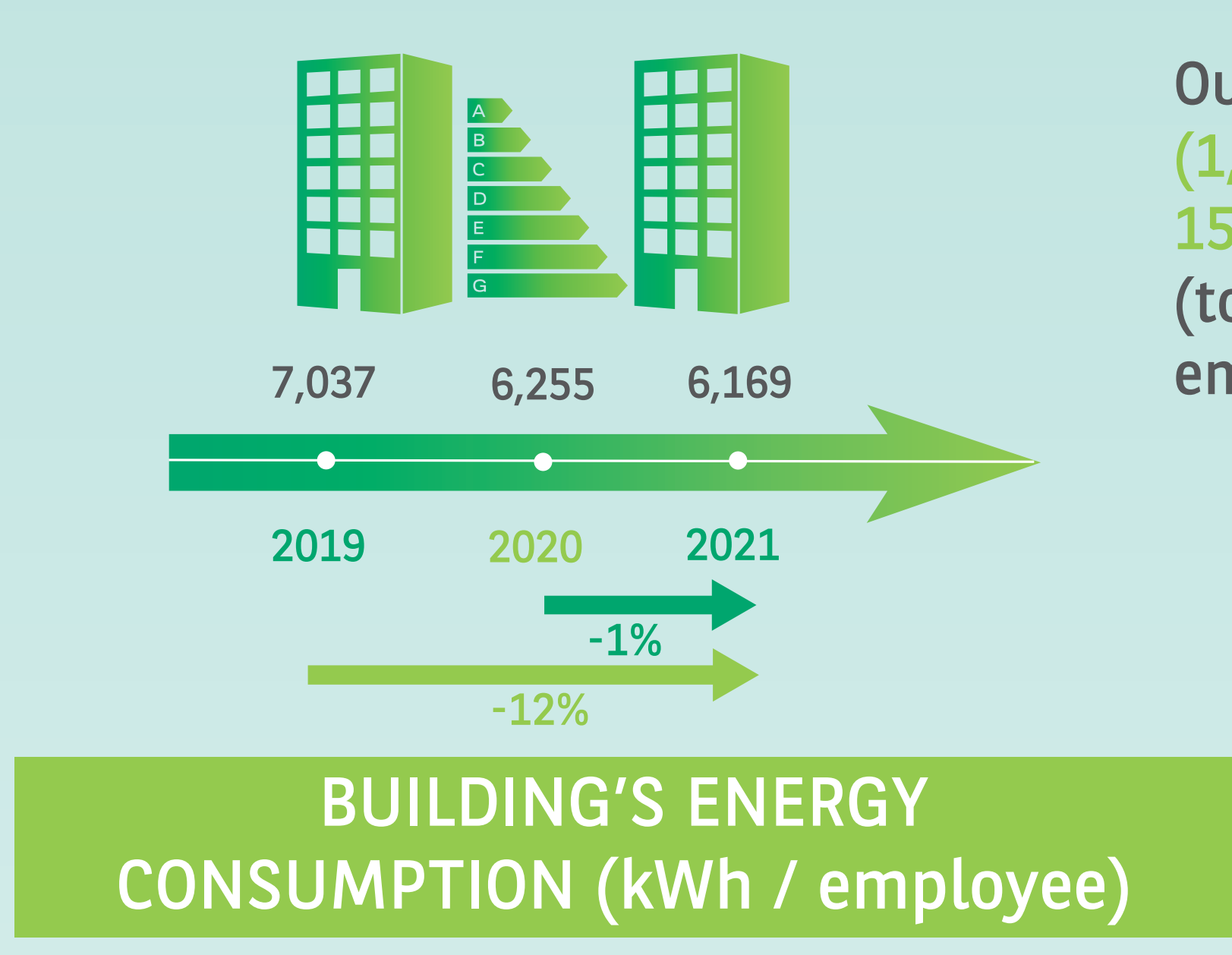
BNP PARIBAS reduces its carbon footprint each year since 2017

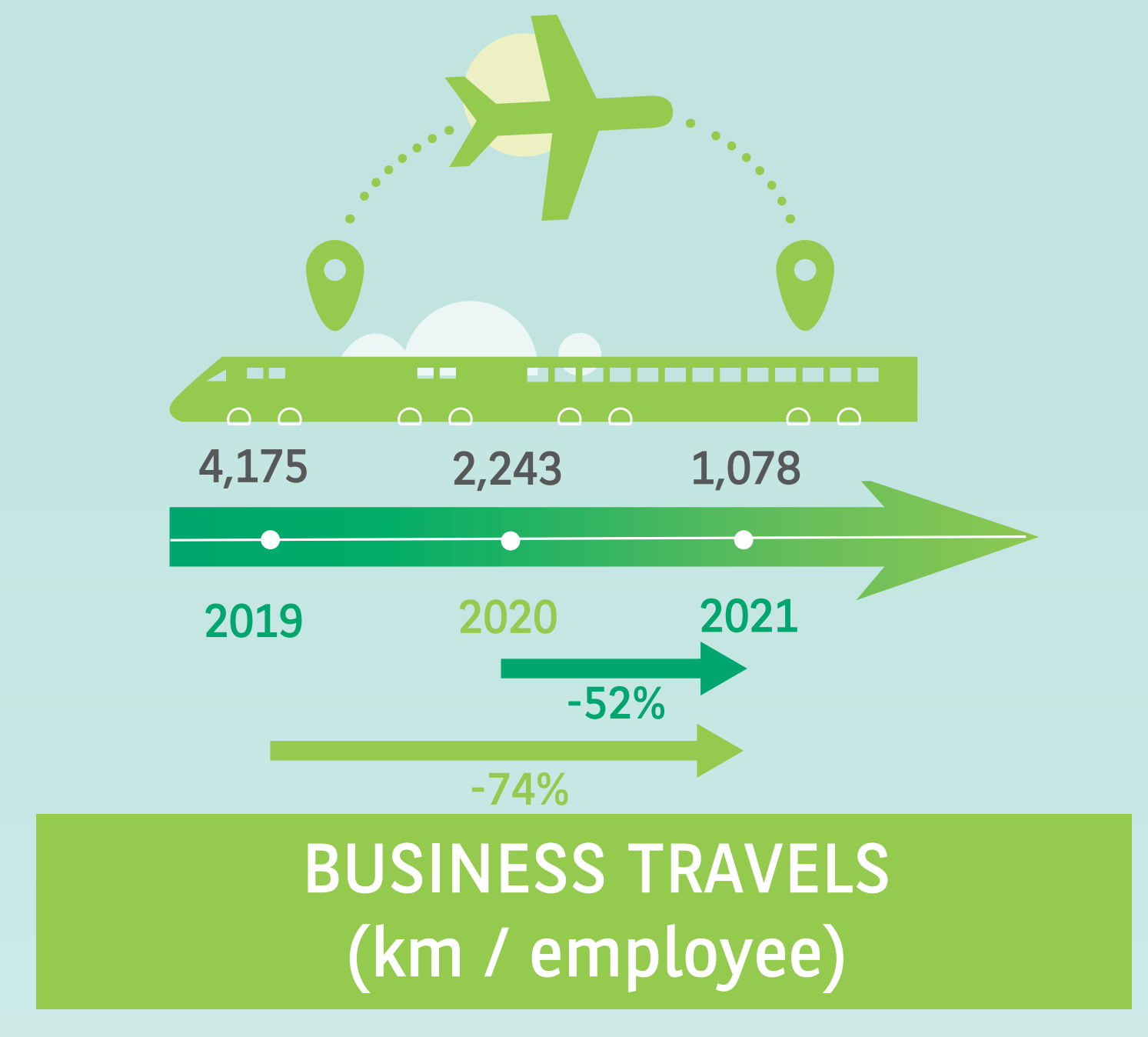
GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS:

Our 2021 energy consumption (1,171 GWh) is equivalent to 156,296 European households (to be compared to the 189,765 employees of the Group).

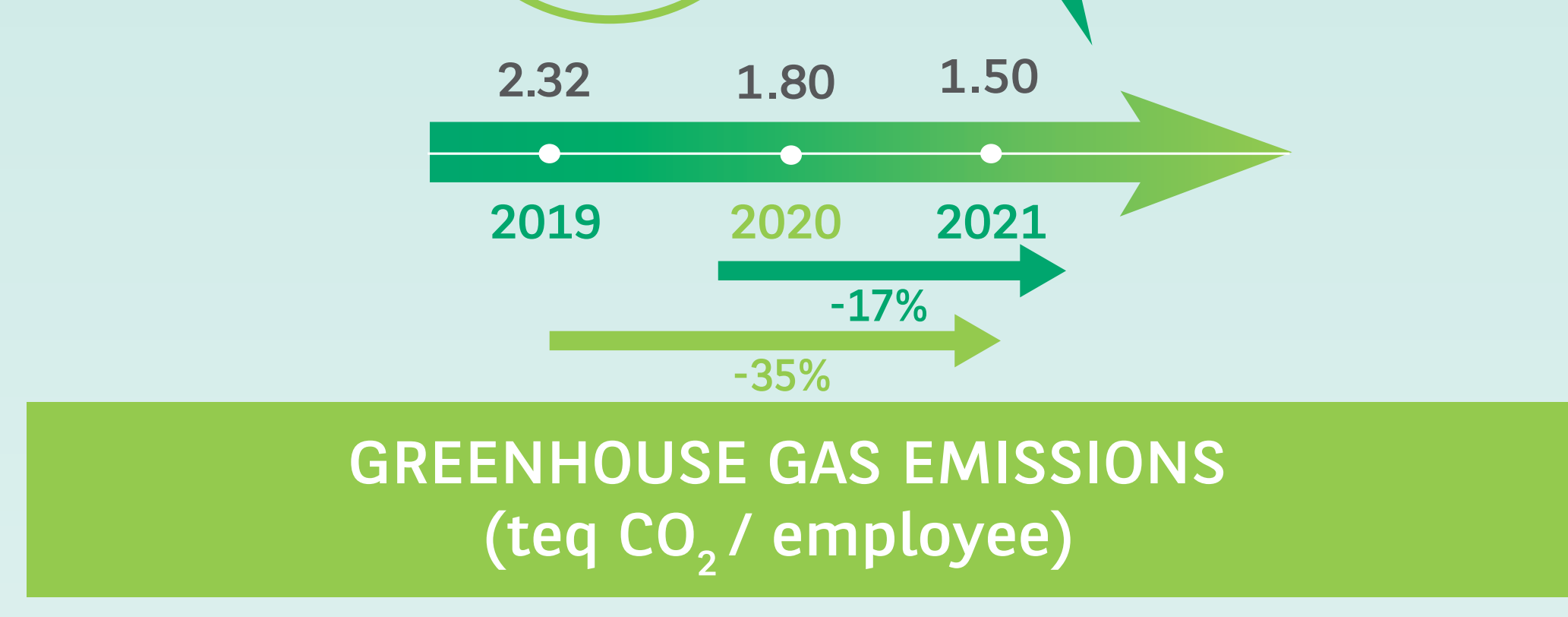
Our 2021 business travels (205 million km) is equivalent to 5,115 round-trips around the Earth.

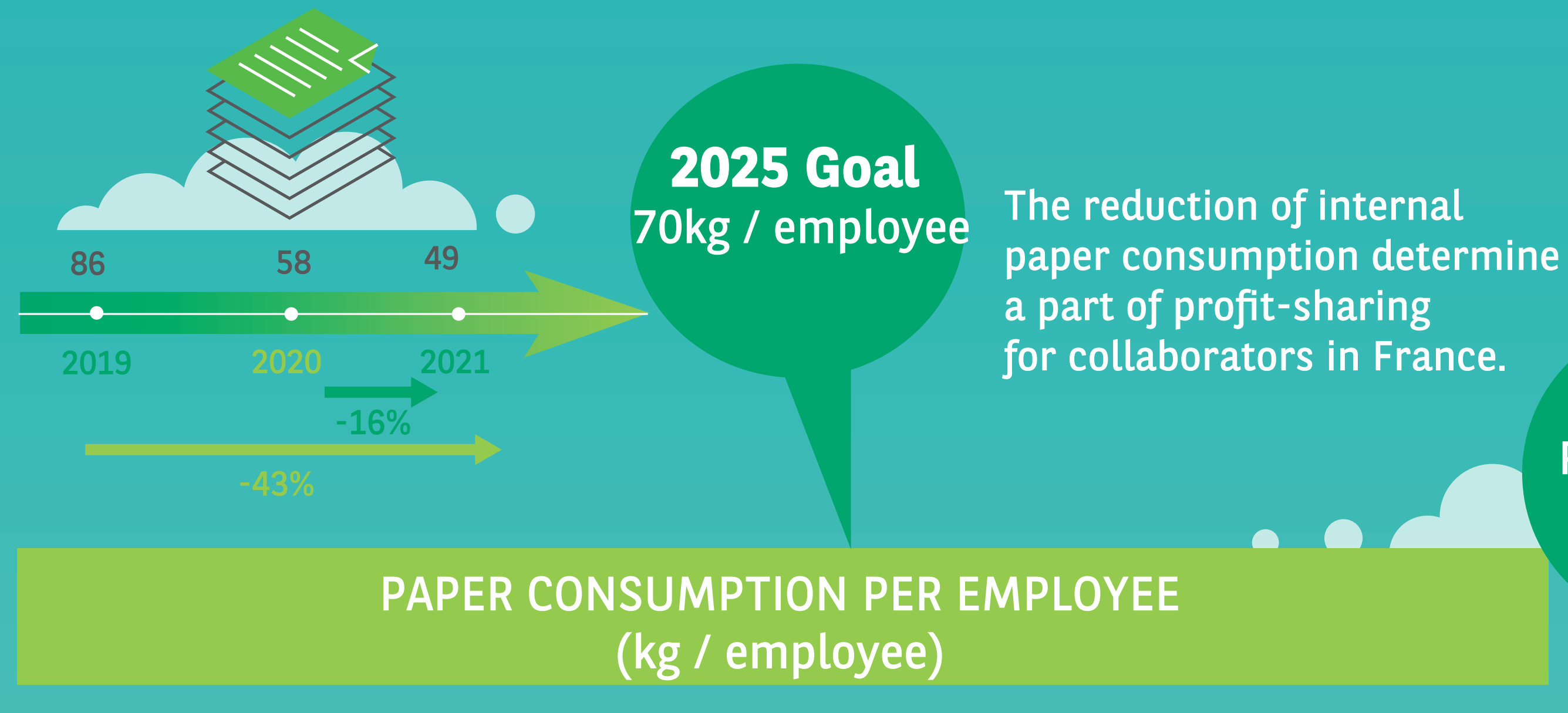

GHG per employee is a criteria included in the long-term compensation plan of the 7,700 key employees of the Group (GSIS).



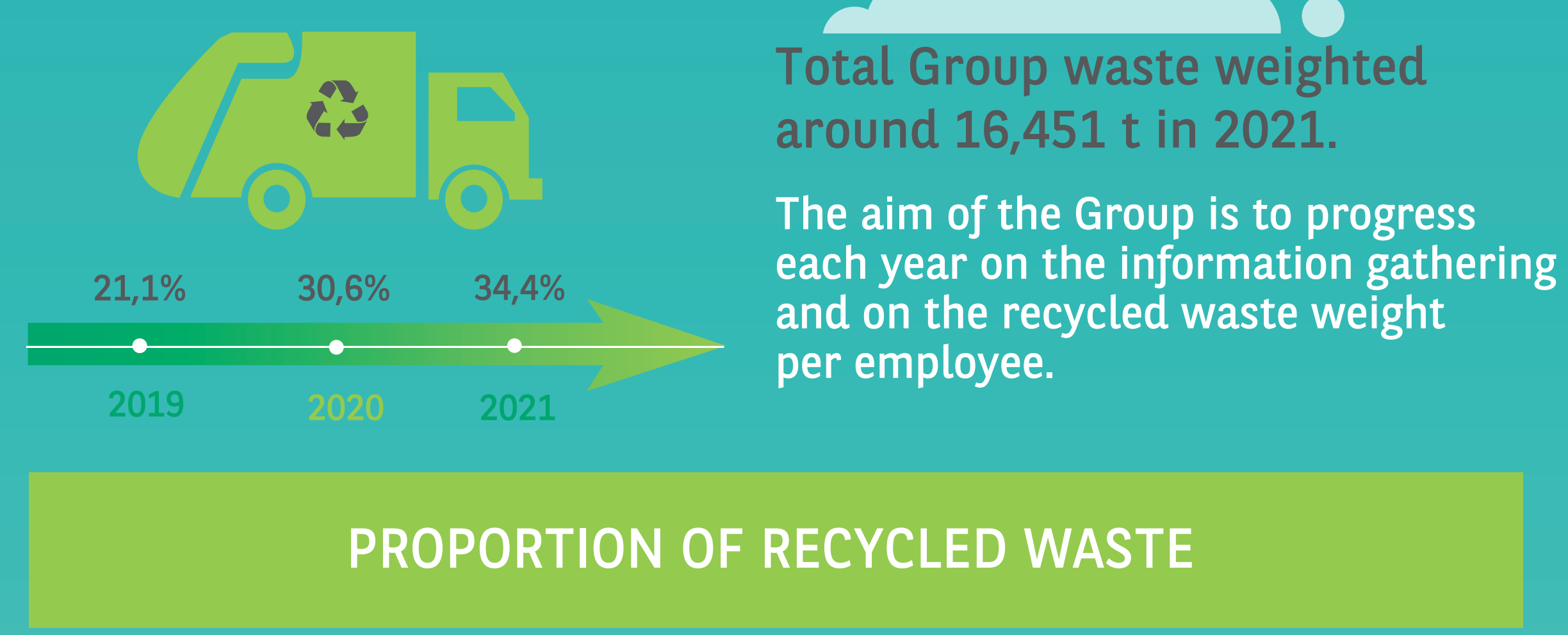
CONSUME LESS AND BETTER

THE GROUP IS COMMITTED TO ENCOURAGING THE CIRCULAR ECONOMY, BY REDUCING ITS PAPER CONSUMPTION AND WASTE PRODUCTION, AND BY RECYCLING WHEREVER IT IS POSSIBLE.



The reduction of internal paper consumption determine a part of profit-sharing for collaborators in France.

Total Group waste weighted around 16,451 t in 2021.

The aim of the Group is to progress each year on the information gathering and on the recycled waste weight per employee.

In 2021, the Group offset 213,911 teqCO₂. This compensation was made for the benefit of 4 projects:

- the preservation and restoration of 200,000 hectares of forest in Kenya with the NGO Wild Life Works;
- the construction of 13,000 gas bio-composters in India with the GoodPlanet Foundation, thus avoiding CO₂ emissions and preserving forests;
- the implementation of improved cooking stones and drinkable water systems to combat child undernutrition in Peru with the local NGO ITYF;
- the conservation of tropical peat bogs covering more than 150,000 hectares of swamp forest located in Indonesia with the NGO Permian Global.
