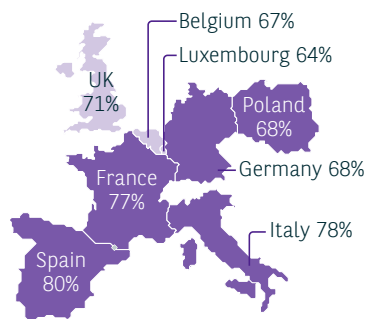


Europeans are aware of the need to take action.

believe that it's **essential to improve the energy performance of homes** in order to combat climate change effectively.



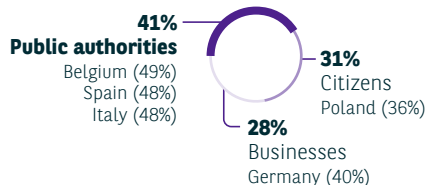
80%

For **41%** of Europeans.

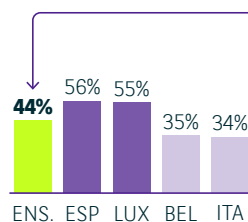


...who nonetheless enjoy a low level of confidence.

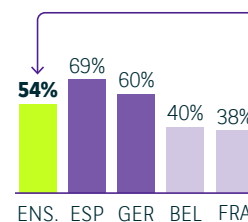

A willingness to take action held back by financial reasons...

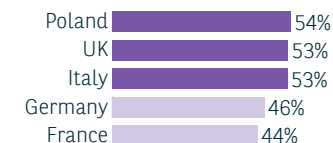
For **76%** of Europeans.
